

San Diego Music Camp Presents the Fifteenth Annual
Strings by the Sea
August 2-6, 2010

Strings by the Sea is a summer music camp for Suzuki string players of all ages, which combines the Suzuki principles of string playing with an awareness of movement and body usage. The seaside camp is held at Point Loma Nazarene University in San Diego, and offers spectacular views of the Pacific Ocean. Classes, held in the Cooper Music building in a nurturing, cooperative, family atmosphere, are Monday, August 2 through Friday, August 6, 2010 from 9am to 4pm (Full-Day session) and 9am to 12pm (Half-Day session), and include:

Repertoire and Technique Classes for Violin, Viola and Cello • Chamber Music (for players in Book 5 and above) • Chamber Orchestra (for players in Book 3 and 4) • String Orchestra (for players in Book 1 and 2) • Fiddling • Jazz • Alexander Technique • Student and Faculty Recitals • Lectures

Performances: Student Recitals will be held on Tuesday, August 3 at 2:00 p.m. Performing a solo in the Student Recital is optional, and any student who wishes may sign up to play; sign up sheets will be on the registration table the first morning of camp, and will be on the camp desk in the lobby the remainder of the day. All pieces performed must be from the Suzuki repertoire, with the exception of students who play in Book 9 and 10, who may choose Suzuki or non-Suzuki repertoire. All students who wish to perform **MUST** consult their private Suzuki teacher for help in selecting the polished, performance-ready piece that they will play. A piano accompanist is provided, however, due to time constraints there will not be the opportunity for a rehearsal prior to the performance. Family and friends are encouraged to attend the performance. The location of each performance, with a list of students taking part in that performance, will be posted and available for parents at the camp desk in the lobby on Tuesday morning, by 8:30 a.m.

Students in Book 5 and above will perform their chamber music in a Works-in-Progress performance, which all students will attend, on Friday at 2:00 p.m. Performance locations and dates will be announced to students and posted by mid-week.

There will be an Orchestra and Beginning/Intermediate Jazz performance, as well as a performance by the Half-Day students, at 9:00 a.m. on Friday, August 6 in Crill Auditorium.

The Final Concert will be held on Friday at 3:00 p.m. Family and friends are invited to attend all faculty and student performances at Strings by the Sea. The Final Concert is expected to end at 4:30 or 5:00 p.m., and will be followed by a Pizza Party to which all campers come at no cost. Guests age 5 and older each pay \$8 for pizza, soda, and cookies. Pizza guests may be paid for with enrollment or may be added during camp.

How to Enroll

Each camper must have a separate Student Enrollment Form and Emergency Information/Photo Release Form; only one camper per form, please. Forms may be photocopied and are available on our website, StringsByTheSea.org. If you are unable to download the Enrollment Packet, please contact us through our email address, info@stringsbythesea.org, or call 858-277-7543.

Applications postmarked after June 15th MUST add a \$50 late fee to the tuition cost.** Your early enrollment ensures proper placement of your camper and receipt of your music before the start of camp.

Students in Book 5 and above: Although we make every effort to accommodate all students, we may have difficulty placing late enrollees in a chamber music group with players of similar experience. Please make every effort to enroll by June 15, and if you wish to enroll an advanced student (Book 5 and above) after June 15, please notify Karla Holland-Moritz at (858) 277-7543.

Prerequisites and Requirements: Campers attending *Strings by the Sea* must be studying privately with a Suzuki teacher who has participated in Suzuki Association of the Americas teacher training, and who is registered as a Suzuki teacher with the SAA or is currently a teacher trainee.

Students ages 7 and younger **MUST** be accompanied by a parent or other adult to ALL classes. Parents of students ages 8 and older are always welcome and encouraged, though not required, to attend their children's classes. Parents who are also Suzuki students may elect to attend Strings by the Sea as campers. Please email us at info@StringsbytheSea.org or call (858) 277-7543 for more information.

Full-Day and Half-Day Sessions: All students who are playing Allegro or beyond by August 2 will, regardless of age, attend as Full-Day campers. Students who are not playing Allegro by August 2 will attend the Half-Day Session; exceptions may be made for school-age students who, though not yet playing Allegro, are able to read music. Half-Day students must be able to play all Twinkle Variations and Twinkle Theme by memory, using fingers and bow together.

Placement: Every student will be scheduled for a Repertoire Class, as well as a Technique Class. Since these classes are assigned according to book, and since the classes will focus to a great extent on the repertoire of that book, students need to be at least half way through the book in order to be able to participate fully in the classes. Students who are not yet half way through their book by July 1 will be assigned to the class of their previous book. If, between the time the student enrolls and July 1, the student progresses to at least half way through their book please contact Strings by the Sea immediately so that placement changes can be made. Family Discount: For any family enrolling more than one immediate family member, the family member discount applies. For example, if one family member is attending the Full-Day Session and another is attending the Half-Day Session, the family would pay \$370 for the first member and \$180 for the second. The Family Discount also applies to parent campers.

Payment: Checks and money orders should be made payable to SAN DIEGO MUSIC CAMP. We accept money orders, personal, bank or cashier's checks. All payments must be made in US dollars drawn on US bank accounts. A \$30 service charge will be attached to any checks returned due to insufficient funds.

Notification: Campers will receive email confirmation of our receipt of their enrollment. Campers without email will be phoned. By July 15 all campers will receive complete camp information, and all Full-Day campers will receive music. Half-Day campers will not receive music, as their classes will be taught by rote.

Scholarships

Partial Tuition Work Scholarships: Need-based partial tuition work scholarships, covering up to a maximum of 50% of the camp tuition, are available through Strings by the Sea for those students who would not be able to attend Strings by the Sea without assistance. The 50% Work Scholarship reduces the tuition for a Full-Day camper to \$185 and for a Half-Day camper to \$105, regardless of whether the camper applying for the scholarship would be eligible for the family discount.

Special Circumstance Full Tuition Work Scholarships: (for families who would not be able to send their children to camp without more than 50% tuition assistance) This work scholarship can provide up to 100% of the tuition, though if families are able to make a contribution of any amount, this helps us extend our scholarships to more families in need.

Viola Scholarships: Strings by the Sea is pleased to offer viola scholarships for 2010. Tuition for Full-Day and Half-Day viola scholarship students is \$100. Viola scholarships are not based on need, nor are they work scholarships. The requirements are below. However, viola students may elect to attend Strings by the Sea on a 50% Tuition Work Scholarship, in which case these requirements do not apply. These requirements also do not apply to viola students paying full tuition:

1. The student must have had a minimum of five months of private Suzuki viola lessons before August 2, 2010.
2. At the time of enrollment, Strings by the Sea must receive an email from the student's Suzuki viola teacher, recommending the student for a Viola Scholarship, describing the student's level of playing and the length of time the student has studied privately.
3. Viola scholarship students may be exclusively studying viola, or they may be violin students who are also studying viola.

If a student plays violin and viola, is receiving a viola scholarship, and wishes to play both violin and viola at Strings by the Sea, please note that on the enrollment form. It may be possible to play both instruments, depending on camp needs, and at the discretion of the Camp Directors.
