

Strings by the Sea

August 1-5, 2011

Strings by the Sea is a summer music camp for Suzuki string players of all ages, which combines the Suzuki principles of string playing with an awareness of movement and body usage. The seaside camp is held at Point Loma Nazarene University in San Diego, and offers spectacular views of the Pacific Ocean. Classes, held in the Cooper Music building in a nurturing, cooperative, family atmosphere, are Monday, August 1 through Friday, August 5, 2011 from 9am to 4pm (Full-Day session) and 9am to 12pm (Half-Day session), and include:

Repertoire and Technique Classes for Violin, Viola and Cello • Chamber Music (for players in Book 5 and above) • Chamber Orchestra (for players in Book 3 and 4) • String Orchestra (for players in Book 1 and 2) • Fiddling • Jazz • Alexander Technique (for players in Book 5 and above) • Student and Faculty Recitals • Lectures (for players in Books 1-4)

How to Enroll

Each camper must have a separate Student Enrollment Form and Emergency Information/Photo Release Form; only one camper per form, please.

Send the completed forms with payment to: SAN DIEGO MUSIC CAMP, 3371 Aveley Place, San Diego, CA 92111-4758. **Early enrollment is advised. Applications postmarked after June 15th MUST add a \$50 late fee to the tuition cost.** Your early enrollment ensures proper placement of your camper and receipt of your music before the start of camp.

Students in Book 5 and above: Although we make every effort to accommodate all students, we may have difficulty placing late enrollees in a chamber music group with players of similar experience. Please make every effort to enroll by June 15, and if you wish to enroll an advanced student (Book 5 and above) after June 15, please notify Karla Holland-Moritz at (858) 277-7543.

Prerequisites and Requirements: Campers attending *Strings by the Sea* must be studying privately with a Suzuki teacher who has participated in Suzuki Association of the Americas teacher training, and who is registered as a Suzuki teacher with the SAA or is currently a teacher trainee.

Students who have not reached their 8th birthday by August 1, 2011 MUST be accompanied by a parent or other adult to ALL classes. Parents of students ages 8 and older are always welcome and encouraged, though not required, to attend their children's classes. Full-Day and Half-Day Sessions: All students who are playing Allegro or beyond by August 1 will, regardless of age, attend as Full-Day campers. Students who are not playing Allegro by August 1 will attend the Half-Day Session; exceptions may be made for school-age students who, though not yet playing Allegro, are able to read music. Half-Day students must be able to play all Twinkle Variations and Twinkle Theme by memory, using fingers and bow together.

Placement: Every student will be scheduled for a Repertoire Class, as well as a Technique Class. Since these classes are assigned according to book, and since the classes will focus to a great extent on the repertoire of that book, students need to be at least half way through the book in order to be able to participate fully in the classes. Students who are not yet half way through their book by August 1 will be assigned to the class of the previous book. If, between the time the student enrolls and August 1, the student progresses to at least half way through the next book please contact Strings by the Sea immediately so that placement changes can be made. Sibling Discount: For any family enrolling more than one child, the sibling discount applies. For example, if one child is attending the Full-Day Session and another is attending the Half-Day Session, the family would pay \$385 for the first child and \$190 for the second.

Payment: Checks and money orders should be made payable to SAN DIEGO MUSIC CAMP. We accept money orders, personal, bank or cashier's checks. All payments must be made in US dollars drawn on US bank accounts. A \$50 service charge will be attached to any checks returned due to insufficient funds.

Notification: Campers will receive email confirmation of our receipt of their enrollment. Campers without email will be phoned. By July 15 all campers will receive complete camp information, and all Book 2 and above campers will receive music. Book 1 Full-Day and Half-Day campers will not receive music, as their classes will be taught by rote.

Scholarships

Strings by the Sea is committed to welcoming and including all students, regardless of family income. In order to be able to continue this policy, we must ask that only those families who are experiencing true financial distress apply for our very limited number of Partial Tuition Work Scholarships or our extremely limited number of Special Circumstances Full Tuition Work Scholarships. Due to the expenses associated with holding a music camp, we depend on full tuition payments from all those who are able to do so. Partial and Full Tuition Work Scholarships are strictly reserved for those families who, without these options, simply would have no means to send their children to Strings by the Sea. We thank you for your help in making sure that no child is left out because of lack of funds. Work Scholarship Application Instructions

1. Complete the [Scholarship Application Form](#), available on our website.
2. Scan and send the Scholarship Application Form by email to Info@StringsByTheSea.org -- or mail the completed form to Strings by the Sea, 3371 Aveley Pl., San Diego, CA 92111-4758.
3. You will receive an email response from Strings by the Sea within 5 days of our receipt of your application. If you have not received our email response within 5 days, please contact us.
4. When you have received our response, sign it and mail it to Strings by the Sea along with the Enrollment Form, other camp forms, and your check. PLEASE DO NOT SEND THE ENROLLMENT FORM UNTIL YOU HAVE RECEIVED OUR RESPONSE.

Partial Tuition Work Scholarships: A very limited number of need-based partial tuition work scholarships, covering up to a maximum of 50% of the camp tuition, are available through Strings by the Sea for those students who would not be able to attend Strings by the Sea without assistance. The Partial Tuition Work Scholarship is able to reduce the full tuition cost to up to 50%, though if families are able to pay more than 50% of the tuition (perhaps by paying the tuition in installments, with the final installment due by July 25), this helps us extend our scholarships to more students. The tuition reduction is based on the full tuition amount, regardless of whether a camper would qualify for the sibling discount.

Special Circumstance Full Tuition Work Scholarships: (for families who would not be able to send their children to camp without more than 50% tuition assistance) An extremely limited number of need-based full tuition work scholarships providing up to 100% of the tuition are available to families whose children would not be able to attend Strings by the Sea without this assistance. If families are able to make a contribution of any amount, this helps us extend our scholarships to more families in need.

Viola Scholarships: Strings by the Sea is pleased to offer viola scholarships for 2011. Tuition for Full-Day and Half-Day viola scholarship students is \$135. The \$135 tuition applies to Full-Day Campers, Half-Day Campers and Sibling Discount Campers (both Full and Half-Day). Viola scholarships are not based on need, nor are they work scholarships. The requirements are below. If a viola student chooses to attend Strings by the Sea without the Viola Scholarship, paying full tuition or partial tuition, the requirements below do not apply.:

1. The student must have had a minimum of five months of private Suzuki viola lessons before August 1, 2011.
2. At the time of enrollment, Strings by the Sea must receive an email from the student's Suzuki viola teacher, recommending the student for a Viola Scholarship, describing the student's level of playing and the length of time the student has studied privately.
3. Viola scholarship students may be exclusively studying viola, or they may be violin students who are also studying viola.

If a student plays violin and viola, is receiving a viola scholarship, and wishes to play both violin and viola at Strings by the Sea, please note that on the enrollment form. It may be possible to play both instruments, depending on camp needs, and at the discretion of the Camp Directors.

A 50% refund will be given for cancellations before June 15th, 2011, after which date refunds will not be given. Cancellations after June 15th, 2011 due to special circumstances will be subject to review.
